From the Letter to Achim Richter on TUD Honorary Doctorate (dated around 12 - 18 Jan 2001): "... This was especially important in his [Bohigas] pioneering research of a deep relation between the already well developed theory of random matrices, a purely statistical one, and the underlaying chaotic dynamics, the brand-new, that time, quantum chaos. This put the firm foundations of the contemporary statistical theory of complex quantum systems. ... The Honorary Doctorate would be a fair recognition of his [Bohigas] important contribution to physics in the last century, and a strong stimulus for farther research in the new millennium.
