- All project reviews take 2h and are restricted sessions only for the project representatives, the reviewers and the project officer.
- These are all final reviews and should concentrate on two aspects:
 - o the work during the last year and comparison with the recommendations of last year's review
 - o assessment of the work over the full lifetime of the project
- All projects have a 30 min time slot (25 min for a public presentation and 5 min for discussion). The public presentation should be neither very technical nor detailed. The slides should not be overcrowded with technical information. The presentation should give an overview of the following in a clear way:
 - O Describe briefly (no more than 10 min of the whole presentation) and in simple language the 2-3 main results achieved by the project at the end of its lifetime.
 - o Situate the project results within the QIPC cluster, compare results and interrelations with other projects, show the place of the project in the larger picture. Please use the QIPC roadmap as a reference.

- Was there collaboration between projects
- The goal is to situate each project with respect to the others and to obtain an overall picture of the achievements of the QIPC cluster.
- Each reviewer is required to attend the public presentation of all the projects he/she is reviewing, the reviews and the conference section on Tuesday. The public presentation contributes also to the review report.
- The conference section will take place on Tuesday 10h00 12h30 and 14h00 15h30. All project representatives, reviewers and POs are requested to attend the conference section.
- QIPC researchers who are not directly involved in any of the reviewed projects are very welcome to attend the conference day on Tue and the public presentations of the projects.
